Thank you for your Freedom of Information request, which was received by the Human Tissue Authority (HTA) on Thursday 14 March 2024. Your email outlined the following request:

Please provide the amount of funding received from the government for the following tax years (20/21,21/22,22/23)".

Response

The HTA is an Executive Agency sponsored by the Department of Health and Social Care (DHSC). The majority of the HTA's funding comes from fees raised from the sector it regulates, but it also receives Grant in Aid funding from DHSC as one of its Arm's Length Bodies. This has consituted around 20% of the HTA's annual income, though the amount can vary depending on business need.
