Directions requiring establishments in the Anatomy sector to submit a compliance update to the Human Tissue Authority (HTA)

These Directions come into force on: 02 September 2019

These Directions remain in force:

Until the Directions are revoked

- 1. These Directions are given in relation to licences issued to Anatomy sector establishments under Sections 16(2)(a), 16(2)(c), 16(2)(d) and 16(2)(e) of the Human Tissue Act 2004.
- 2. The Directions require licensed Anatomy establishments to submit information about licensable activities being undertaken.
- 3. Submissions must be made to the HTA no later than 18 October 2019.
- 4. Detailed instructions for completing the submission are provided in a separate document, which is available on the HTA website at: https://www.hta.gov.uk/policies/guide-submitting-compliance-updates-using-hta-portal
- 5. The information required by these Directions will be used to:
 - a. Ensure each establishment's continued suitability to be licensed
 - b. Inform the scheduling of site-visit inspections
 - c. Inform the HTA's regulatory approach to each sector
